



FLU; COVID; RSV VACCINATIONS

Sorry for the long message. As you may already be aware Flu vaccinations normally commence in September each year. This year there has been a change to the flu vaccination programme.

We are currently administering RSV vaccination for the Eligible cohort:

- Patients aged 75 -79 years
- Pregnant Ladies (28 weeks) – Can also have flu vaccination in September

During September we will also be giving Nasal flu vaccinations to

- Children aged 2 & 3 (date of birth between- 01/09/2020 – 31/8/2022)
- Children 6 months – 17 in an At Risk Group (i.e diabetic etc)

We have a special clinic for this on **Saturday 21st September** please contact reception to book appointment.

From 3rd October we are able to give flu and Covid vaccinations to eligible patients:

- Aged 65 and over (by 31/03/2025)
- Patients aged 18-64 with a Chronic Disease i.e Asthma; Diabetes; heart condition; stroke etc

For Patients wanting both flu and Covid Vaccinations, these can be co-administered (at the same time, one in each arm) or can be given separately.

We are now booking for our clinics for all the above vaccinations.

- 🌈 RSV vaccinations most weekdays in September
- 🌈 Nasal Flu Childrens session Saturday 21st September
- 🌈 Pregnant Ladies weekdays in September with Nurses
- 🌈 Flu vaccinations for all Eligible patients clinics on from 3rd October
- 🌈 Saturday Flu and Covid booster clinic – 5th October
